

#### Plane Disaster in Penguinville


# Certain Parts of Penguinville deemed off limits to buses

A plane attempted a take off at the F1 test track earlier this week.

The plane managed to lift off the ground and gain some altitude, it was in the air for an estimated 30 seconds before the pilot lost control while attempting to land on the 'runway'.




Plane flying over F1 Test Track

Although the planes engines were damaged beyond repair, the plane itself was relatively undamaged, apart from damage to the front wheel and slight deformation of the undercarriage.

A plane crash occurred in Penguinville this Thursday, the Twin Otter struck the sky scraper at a low speed instantly disabling its engines, the plane fell down the side of the sky scraper becoming wedged between the sky scraper and a smaller building half way down.
